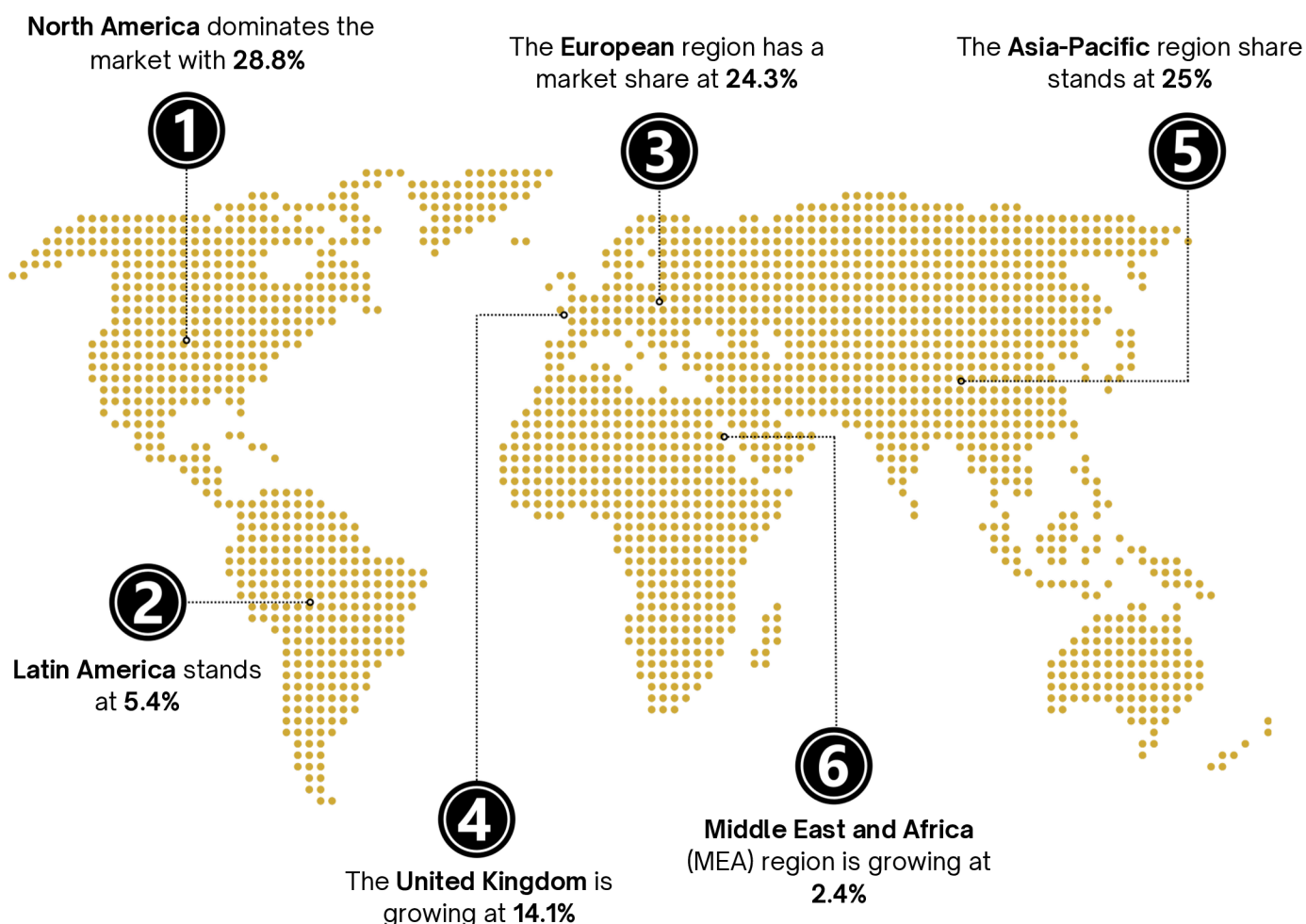


Figure 1: Global Market Share of AI

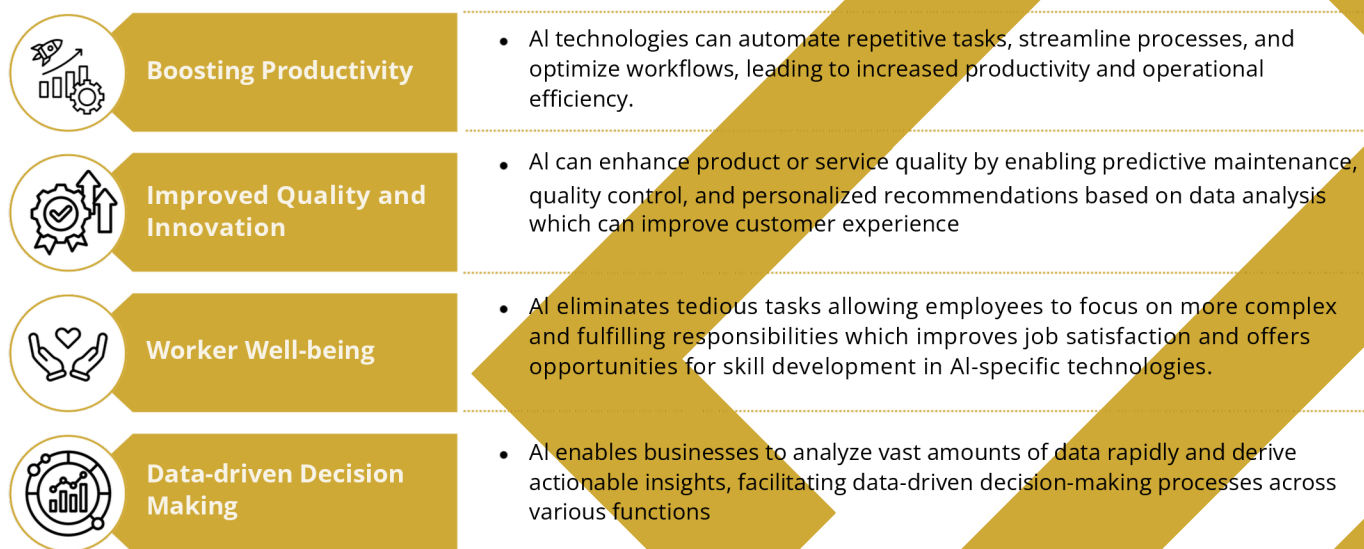


Figure 2: Transformation of Businesses with AI

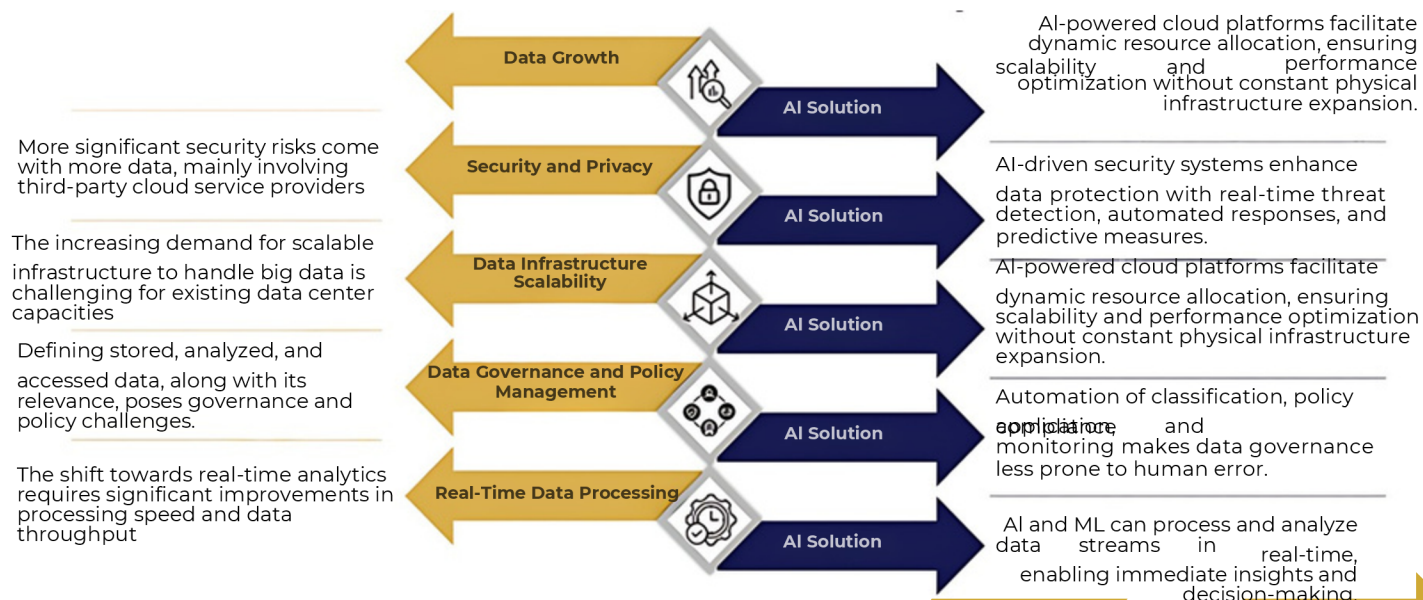


Figure 3: Addressing Current Business Challenges Using AI

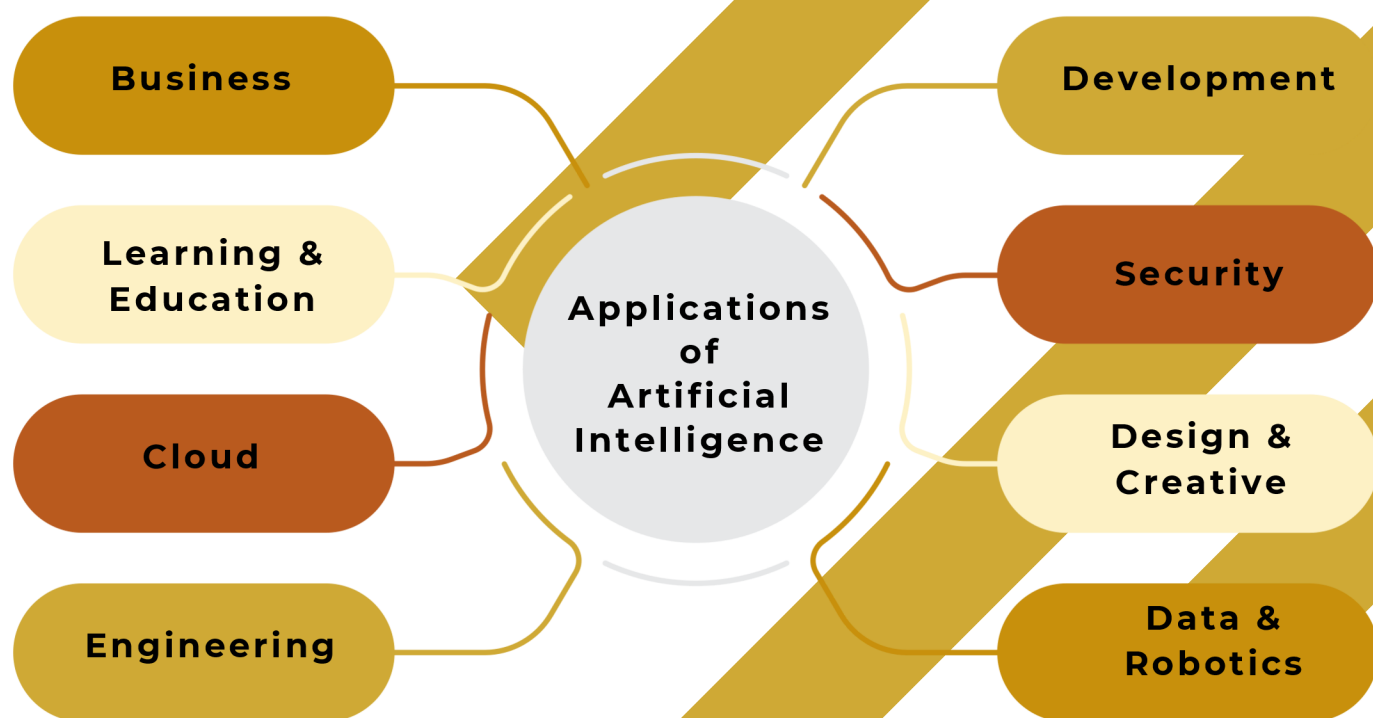


Figure 6: Applications of AI

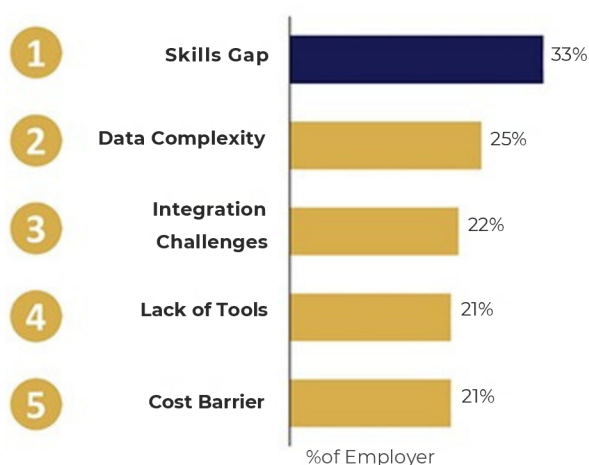

Share of employers saying lacking AI skills is a barrier to adopt AI (2023)

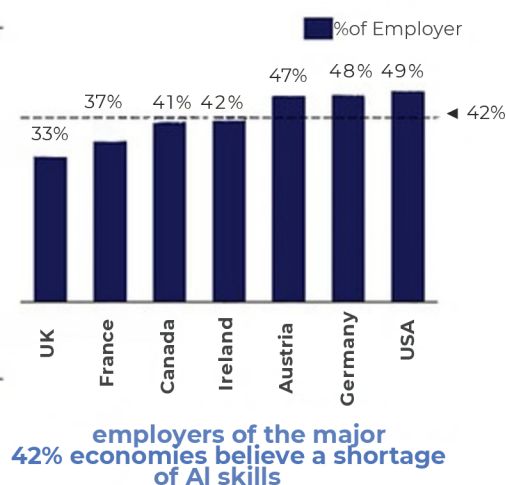


Figure 7: Factors determining the lack of adopting AI Technologies
